Two Categories:

1) Front Cover - design must include the
School name and school year

2) Back Cover - a design only

Guidelines:

- Use 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper.
- Use the paper vertically.
- Any art medium may be used - crayons, paint, pastels, markers, color pencils, etc.
Using materials that create texture give added dimension to the design.
- What you choose to design for the cover is up to you.
- Your design must be in color. Avoid leaving the background blank or white.
- Keep what's important in the your design (like the school name) away from the edges of the paper.
- Write your first and last name, grade, room number, and teacher name on the BACK of your cover design.
- All entries receive a participation award.
